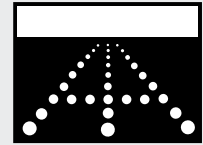

Full Scale Emergency Exercise at ANR ROBINSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Airports Authority of Trinidad and Tobago ("the Authority")
will be conducting a full scale emergency exercise on

Wednesday 16th May, 2018
from 10:00 am – 12:00 pm at the
ANR Robinson International Airport

The public is advised that there will be an interruption in vehicular traffic flow along the public roadway giving access to Kilgwyn Bay to facilitate easy access by emergency response agencies. The Police will be controlling and directing traffic accordingly.

The purpose of this simulation exercise is to test and evaluate the preparedness of the Authority and relevant stakeholders to respond in the event of an incident at the ANR Robinson International Airport. This exercise is conducted in compliance with Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation regulations to ensure that the highest level of safety and security measures are in place at the airport.

The travelling public is asked to communicate with their respective airlines to confirm flight times during this period. We thank the public for your support as we continue to maintain the highest level of safety and security at our airports for the benefit of all of our customers.
